Free a Girl is an international organisation dedicated to freeing young girls from forced prostitution. The organisation also invests in shelter, medical care, education, vocational training and reintegration of survivors. In the past 8 years we have contributed to the liberation of more than 3.700 girls from brothels in Asia. We also work together with law enforcement and the judiciary system for arresting and prosecuting human traffickers.

Free a Girl raises awareness in the Netherlands and in our five programme countries about the problem of commercial sexual exploitation of children and the need to fight and prevent it. Free a Girl supports its partner organisations to conduct their own fundraising and lobby activities in their own country and region.

The organisation's activities are financed through its own fundraising initiatives, grants and strategic partnerships with institutional donors and companies. Free a Girl maintains a regular presence in the media by using free publicity.
